

Terms of Use

These Terms of Use (“Terms”) are entered into by and between you (“you,” “your,” or “user”) and US Pediatric Partners, LLC (“US Pediatric Partners,” “we,” “our,” or “us”), a pediatric medical practice located in Florida. These Terms govern your access to and use of this website and any other webpage or digital service operated by US Pediatric Partners that links to these Terms (collectively, the “Site”).

US Pediatric Partners reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to update or modify these Terms at any time. Any changes will be effective upon posting. Your continued use of the Site following such changes constitutes your acceptance of the revised Terms.

1. United States Website

2. Authorized Users
